

EBU Admissions Policy

Intent

To specify and outline the Admission Procedure for all students across all EBU courses.

Scope

This policy applies to applications and offers made by the admissions department of EBU, to domestic and international students across all tertiary study degrees and departments.

Principles

1. Formal Academic Offers are to be made through consistent and unbiased decision-making.
2. Formal Academic Offers will only be made to applications who have been assessed to hold the relevant pre-requisites for the course applied.
3. EBU is supportive of students of all demographic backgrounds, including those of educational and social disadvantage.
4. Students are responsible for referencing the course outlines to understand all requirements expected of them to enroll, continue and/or complete the course.

Policy

1. All Formal Applications are to be made through the EBU website application form.
2. All Formal Offers are to be made by an approved EBU Admissions Officer and Academic Dean, in accordance with the Admissions Procedure.
3. Eligibility for an Offer will be determined in accordance with the Admissions Procedure, Course pre-requisites and Previous professional history.
4. Applicants who are ineligible for their applied course may be considered for alternative courses if available.
5. EBU may limit formal places made using quotas or other limits in accordance with the Admissions Procedure.
6. Entry Requirements for International students will not be less than the minimum entry requirements for European students.
7. EBU may approve special admission schemes and support affirmative action to support groups of students from educational, social or financial disadvantage.
8. A person who has been suspended or excluded from a course at this University, will be denied subsequent applications, enrolment or Academic Offers.
9. An application who provides inaccurate, incomplete, fraudulent or misleading information or documentation will have their offer or their subsequent admission withdrawn.
10. EBU reserves the right to withdraw an Offer, where an Offer was incorrectly made, when an Offer has not been accepted during the relevant time frame given, or when the course has been discontinued or suspended.
