

EBU Academic Scholarship Guidelines

Academic Scholarship Award Guidelines

Conditions of compliance

The following guidelines apply to all EBU scholarships unless specifically exempted or modified by the Academic Dean or stated otherwise.

1. **Terms of Enrollment:** Scholarships will be distributed for the fall and spring semesters. Scholarships may not be applied to summer terms. Scholarships are renewable for up to three consecutive years of enrollment.
2. **Enrollment Status:** Scholarship recipients must be continually enrolled in each term.
3. **Grade Point Average:** Recipients must maintain the following minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) at the end of each academic year to be eligible for renewal. If a student falls below the required GPA level, a forfeiture of the scholarship will occur. Once the student achieves the necessary GPA, the scholarship may be reinstated.
4. Students must meet all Student Honor Code and Student Conduct Code requirements

Your scholarship is awarded as a tuition waiver.

5. This award will be automatically applied to your tuition expense each semester for the award period.
6. This award cannot be used toward other fees (i.e. enrolment commitment, activity fees, housing, correspondence courses, etc).
7. In the event of early graduation, unused semester funds will be forfeited.
8. If the student is unenrolled, the scholarship will be forfeited, and the scholarship may be revoked.

Please note:

Program Requirements

1. **Enrolment** –Scholarship recipients must enrol each semester. This means that all webinar attendance and timely completion of all assessments, i.e. without extensions or deferrals, is mandatory with no exceptions.
2. **Grade Point Average** – Students who show academic success through an EBU GPA of 3.00 or higher will remain eligible.

GPA's are checked at the end of the academic year.

Probation Guidelines

1. If a recipient does not meet the required overall webinar attendance or EBU GPA requirement, the student will be placed on probation for one academic year. Students will continue to receive their scholarships only during the first semester of the probationary period. Students will have the same one-semester calendar year to achieve the required overall EBU GPA. If the overall EBU GPA is not earned by the end of the semester, the award will be discontinued.
2. If a student's GPA increases to the minimum requirement or above, the scholarship will be reinstated. Upon reinstatement, the scholarship conditions apply. The student will have the opportunity to continue the program.
3. If a student observes the required webinar attendance and timely completion of all assessments but does not pass the course assessments, the student will be enrolled for a retake without the requirement of a commitment fee payment.
