

ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT FOR THE EBU VIRTUAL LEARNING PLATFORM

The European Business Institute of Luxembourg (EBU) virtual learning environment is built on a Learning Management System, which has been independently audited and accredited as conforming to the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) Level AA.

The EBU virtual learning environment is designed to provide equal functionality and information to all users, regardless of all challenges. The built-in assistive technology, for screen size, or input devices includes support for screen readers and text-to-speech software, keyboard-only navigation, high-contrast viewing, zooming of content, and the use of headings and structured markup to support efficient navigation for vision impaired users, including the use of commonly available screen readers and other assistive technologies to perceive and interact with course materials.

The EBU virtual learning environment also supports learners who are hearing impaired through the provision of text-based content, support for captions and transcripts for multimedia resources, and tools that enable our faculty to provide alternative textual equivalents where audio information is used. These capabilities build on Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) Level AA-conformant core and related accessibility tooling (such as accessibility checking of course content) to reduce barriers to participation.
